

The wise and the foolish builders- A parable from Jesus

- Many people think that hearing the words of Jesus and then saying the sinner's prayer is all that's needed for salvation. However, the Parable of The Wise and Foolish Builders certainly seems to tell a different story.
- God has us under construction. Physically, we grow. Mentally, we grow. Spiritually, (hopefully) we grow, BTW – by spiritually, I mean our relationship with God.
- Anyway the main point in this parable from Jesus has to do with whether or not the things we do in this life will lead us to do what God wants us to do or if we are going to ignore the things in his instruction manual (the Bible) and do what we feel is best.



<u>Play a game</u>



- Play the game of 'Simon says'(You could alter the wording to 'The Bible Says' or 'Jesus says'). This gets children into thinking about the importance of obedience, and in this this case, obedience to God.
- Give each child (or put them in small teams) some marshmallows and uncooked spaghetti. Give them a set time to try to build the tallest structure that stands.
- Sit in a circle. Select 1 person to be the guesser who turns their back to the circle temporarily. Give a small rock/stone to one person in the circle. Can it be passed around the circle without the guesser working out who is holding it?

- What must a person do to be like the wise man that built his house on a rock?
- What things could keep you form putting God's Word into practice? What might stop you?
- What life changes can you make to be more like the wise man? How can you be better at putting God's word into practice?
